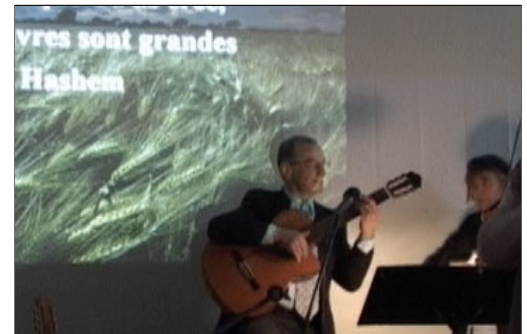

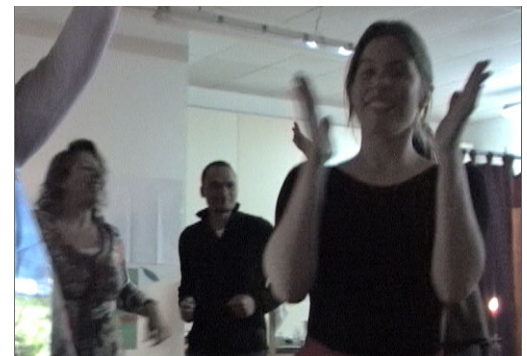


Dear friends and supporters we want to wish you a wonderful Thanksgiving.
